

Express Scripts manages the prescription plan for the New Mexico Public Schools Insurance Authority.

**Starting on July 1, 2016**, certain medicines such as oral antihistamines, nasal corticosteroids, and proton-pump inhibitors will *no longer be covered and filled through home delivery*. Please see page 2 for the list of some of the common names for these medicines. You will only be able to fill these prescriptions at a retail pharmacy and will be required to pay a *100% copayment*. If appropriate, you may consider purchasing an over-the-counter (OTC) alternative. OTC medicines are available for purchase without a prescription in many retail locations.
